Parish Link Program

The WA Parish Link Program aims to:

1. Renew an interest in CEBS for those who have been involved in the past.
2. Spread, introduce, motivate the “good news” of CEBS at their parish level.
3. Extend the network of those who could possibly assist, even in some small active way.
4. Be a ‘catalyst’ for support and encouragement to leaders.

The program seeks out past leaders and members who have had some commitment to CEBS in the past.

These people are asked to come on an email or mailing group who get sent copies of diocesan minutes, lists of activities, any other item of interest. They are then asked to comment on any or all of these, if they wish.

If they are in a parish where an active CEBS branch exists leaders are asked to keep them up to date on what is happening in that group.

If they are older people, boys could ‘adopt’ them as branch ‘god parents’.

If they are in a parish where CEBS does not exist they could find ways where CEBS could assist in children’s ‘mission’ as part of an outreach program.

Eventually, there may be ways of establishing CEBS in that parish.

The first step is to gather names of people who wish to go on to this group. This can be done through past records, at synod, or through an article in your diocesan paper.
