

CEBS Australia Web Site Policy
(as approved at CEBS National Council 22-24 April 2005)
(Draft 2)

- Photographs of children should only appear with the parent's/guardian's consent.
- Meeting times and places are not to be advertised on any CEBS website. Only a contact person who can subsequently provide this information. No surnames of children to be published on the internet. First names are OK.

(Note these are for child protection reasons)

- Content should be appropriate for a Christian society and not in conflict with the Objects of the society.

If branches/groups wish to have a link on the National CEBS web pages they must comply with the above and also:

- Need to be a registered Branch with an affiliated body of CEBS Australia.
- Must have a link on their site back to the National CEBS Home page.

Example Parent consent wording:

I hereby authorise and give my consent to my/my child's first name and/or photograph to be used for any purpose in the promotion of CEBS - The Anglican Boys Society.
