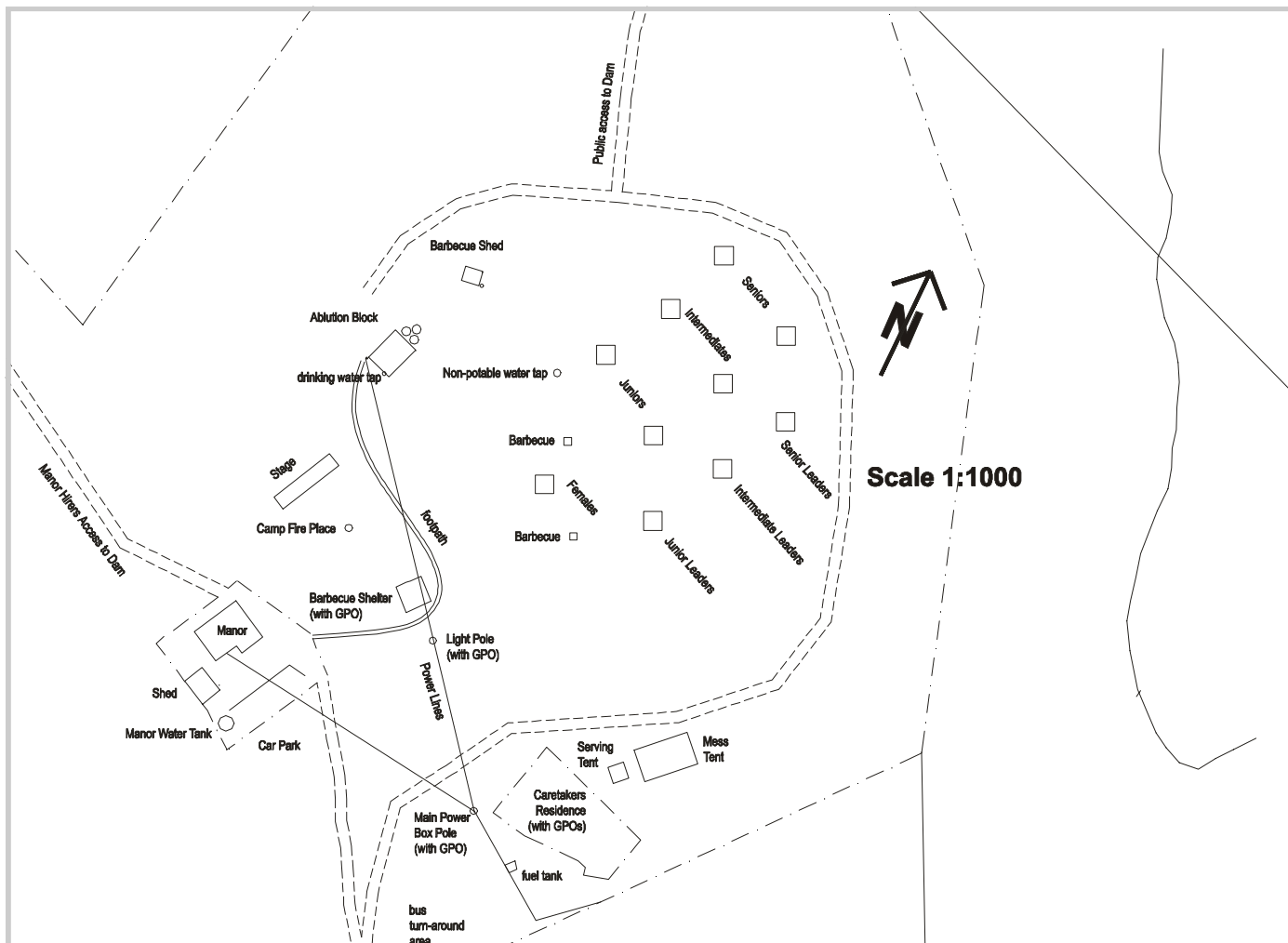

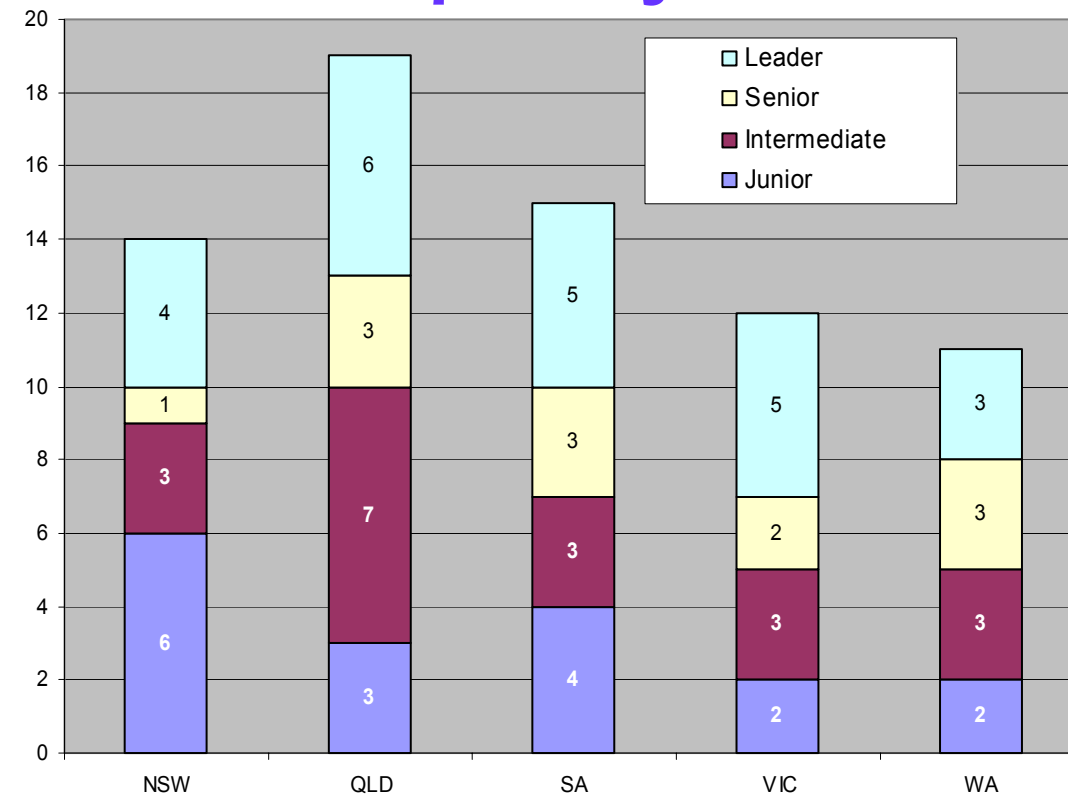

**Tribal Laws**

to make your camp enjoyable, safe and to help you survive.

1. Slip, Slop, Slap. Whenever you are outdoors wear a Shirt & Hat and apply Sunscreen and re-apply every 2 hours. When swimming wear a sunsafe swimming / rash shirt. This will save on sunscreen.
2. Footwear should be worn at all times at the site except when swimming, sleeping and showering. Sandals, aqua shoes or old sandals must be worn while canoeing and swimming in the Dam.
3. Stay in your group. When on activities or excursions stay with your small tribe. Your tribe leader is responsible for you and therefore must know where you are at all times. If you get lost there will be emergency contact phone numbers provided.
4. Don't touch or approach the cattle or wildlife. Leave snakes alone and they will leave you alone. Report any injuries or illnesses to your tribe leader immediately.
5. Boundaries. You are not to go outside the fence line unless on an activity or excursion. The caretaker's house is out of bounds unless invited. The Manor house is out of bounds except for first aid and female showers & toilets downstairs. The ablution block is for males only.
6. Fires. No fires are to be lit anywhere except in the designated fireplaces only with Leader supervision, except when there is a Total Fire Ban in the district.
7. Water for drinking and showering is available, but is usually in short supply, so that care needs to be taken in its use. Don't waste water. There are two barbecues and a non-drinking water tap nearby. Drinking water is available at a single tap outside the ablution block and in drink containers in the mess tent. Fill your wa-

ter bottles from these places only and Drink at least 2 litres of water every day. Take your water bottle with you every day and fill it up every chance you get. Drink water before you get thirsty!!

8. Buoyancy Vests must be worn on all water activities on the dam.
9. Lights Out. Every night at lights out everyone is to quieten down and go to bed to sleep. You will need your sleep after the activities each day.
10. Tents. Keep your tents clean & tidy. Put all rubbish in the bins. Leave damp or wet clothes out of your bag or hang them up somewhere. Roll your sleeping bags / gear up each day to prevent invasion by pests including snakes.
11. Hygiene. To survive the camp and stay healthy, everyone is to have a shower each day and wash your hands before every meal and after using the toilets.
12. Bushwalking. When bushwalking stay together in your tribe and stay on the tracks.
13. Respect and have consideration for everyone else on the camp and the public who come into contact with and have fun. Smile.
14. Obey all instructions given to you by the camp leaders.
